Mohave County School Superintendent John Warren has announced a vacancy on the Owens Elementary School District Governing Board.

The opening was created by the resignation of veteran Board Member Darla Lange due to personal reason. We appreciate Ms. Lange's service to the district and wish her the very best in the future. Ms. Lange's term was scheduled to end on December 31, 2028. The resignation is effective April 9, 2026.

Candidates may include letters of recommendation or support if they wish.

To be eligible to hold this seat a person must; be a registered voter, be a citizen of the United States of America, be at least 18 years of age, possess their civil rights, have continually resided within the school district for at least one year immediately preceding taking office, and they or their spouse cannot be employed by the school district or by a third party provider.

Mr. Warren will interview candidates at the Owens Elementary School District offices or via a virtual meeting if all qualifications are met. The appointment would be announced and become effective on as soon as a successful candidate is selected and would be valid through December 31, 2028.
